Elementary Offerings

Please sign up by Wednesday, May 26th

K-2 Math/Reading Remediation - Teachers will provide opportunities for students to increase their math and reading skills. This will be available between the hours of 9:00-11:00 a.m. on the following Wednesdays: June 16, 23, 30, July 14, 21, 28, August 4, 11.

3rd-5th Math/Reading Remediation - Teachers will provide opportunities for students to increase their math and reading skills. This will be available between the hours of 9-11 a.m. on the following Tuesdays and Thursdays: June 15, 17, 22, 24, 29, July 1, 13, 15, 20, 22, 27, 29, August 3, 5, 10, 12.

Volleyball Skills for grades 3-5 and 6-8 - Teachers will provide opportunities for students to learn volleyball skills. This will take place on June 15th, 16th, and 17th from 10:00-11:00 for 3-5 grade students and 11:30-1:00 for grade 6-8.
