Public Power Scholarship

Eligibility guidelines

- 1. High school senior may submit an essay to win a scholarship. The student (or their parent or legal guardian) must be a graduating senior from the Forest Park High School.
- 2. High school senior must plan to attend either (1) line worker training or (2) a two-year technical college or a four-year university with a major/emphasis in electrical engineering or energy management.
- 3. Essays should be on the theme: *Our Community Connection: The Value of Our Municipal Utility*. Essays should be between 500 and 1,000 words typed and double-spaced and include the following information on the cover:
 - Student's first and last name
 - Home address
 - Phone number
 - Name of parent or legal guardian
- 4. Please submit all essays to the high school guidance office.
