SELECTION CRITERIA

One male and one female graduating student are eligible scholarship recipients. They will receive a one-time scholarship award chosen from Forest Park High School.

Eligibility:

1. The students awarded this scholarship must have the intent to be accepted in a program at a college, university or technical school. There is no restriction on their chosen field of higher education.
2. The student must attend the education program during the year immediately following his/her high school graduation, beginning with the first regular semester or term.
3. This scholarship is available to students with a 3.25 GPA. A transcript of the student's high school transcript must be supplied to demonstrate that the student has the required GPA.
4. The student must have two character references, one from a teacher and one from a person who is familiar with the student (not family). Each reference must demonstrate the student's honesty, good citizenship and skills to succeed in their chosen field of study, citing specific examples of such.
5. The student must attach a separate essay with the application. The essay must comment on why they have chosen their particular field of study.
6. The individual financial need of the applicant for scholarship assistance will be a consideration by the scholarship committee when applicants have met all other criteria for the scholarship.
7. Payment of the scholarship is made to the recipients as soon as they provide verification of registration in their school of higher education.
8. The applications, transcripts, statements and references need to be submitted to the Guidance office.

Addendum:

A scholarship award may be revoked by the Board of Trustees of the Crystal Falls Area Community Fund and/or Dickinson Area Community Foundation because of:

Criminal or anti-social conduct of recipient.

Filing false information on the application.

For such other good cause as the Board may, in its sole discretion, determine.

Revocation shall be by the action of a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees, and upon such revocation, any and all funds still controlled by the Board of Trustees, shall be withheld and disposed of at the discretion of the Board.
